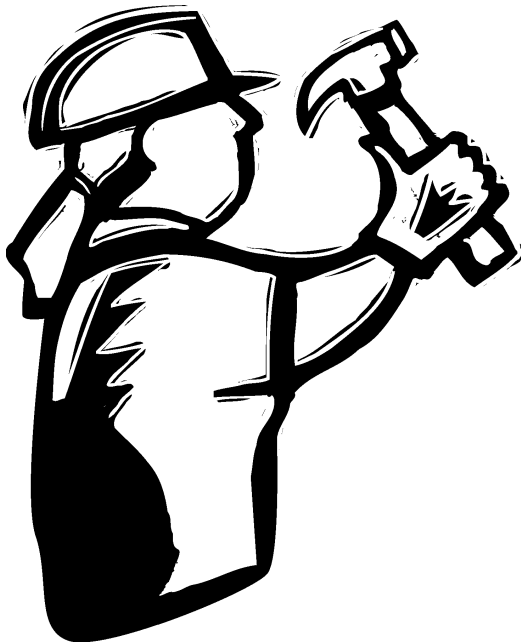

**Servant Heart Ministries**

An outreach of Camp Kingswood, Servant Heart Ministries works to grow servant hearts in participants. It works to help participants grow in physical and servant skills. It helps fill physical, social, and emotional needs in the communities it works with. It offers a number of programs for adults, high school students and middle school students.

**Kingswood Camp & Retreat Center**

Offers year round facilities that include basketball, volley ball, disc golf, swimming beach, canoes, camp-fire rings, prairie, 7+ miles of trails, aqua bikes, along with winter events such as snowshoeing, sled-ding, and broomball. It offers rope courses and tree climbing. It is fully accredited.

It also offers a 20 acre campground, bathhouse, cabin tents, RV sites, pavilion, and beach access. Kingswood Lodge sleeps 30 with 1 large meeting Tamarack Lodge sleeps 36.
